Greetings from the Board of Trustees!



I hope everyone's 2022 is shaping up to be better than 2021! I have so appreciated being able to gather in person with all of you. I am especially grateful to our worship committee – Sue McIntire, Carolyn Holmes and Rebecca St.Clair – they have successfully curated amazing experiences for our community through extremely challenging circumstances. The choir (with Sue's leadership) and the combination of our congregational leaders and consulting ministers make me feel so grateful to have a church home.

We also want to thank Barb Witte for her service to our community. Her care of the building and the administrative services she provides are deeply appreciated. Big thank you to Jim Stier and Kim Burr for their continued efforts to work out the glitches with the elevator – being an accessible congregation is so close!!

In the spirit of keeping our community informed about our COVID safety protocols, the board continues to track the county data regarding infection rates. Currently, we are continuing with masking and social distancing as well as asking in-person service participants to continue to sign in when they enter the building. Also, if you test positive and have attended in-person services, please contact the board in case we need to notify others who were in attendance. Please keep in mind that while some of these practices may feel extreme, we are doing our best to protect those among us who are most vulnerable. If you have concerns you want the board to know about, join us for our meetings on the third Monday of the month at 6:30pm or send any of us an email. We recently recertified with the UUA. While we are experiencing the same challenges as many other churches during the pandemic, we remain in strong fiscal health, and I am cautiously optimistic despite lower attendance numbers. This is a time for our community to think about what we want our congregation to be moving forward. The board will spend the next several weeks in conversation and exploration on "what's possible for us" – to be followed by community conversations with our congregation.
